

Program Overview

Tristar Reads is an annual contest designed to encourage students across Tennessee to read throughout their summer break. The program will run from May 28th-August 4th, 2024, and is open to all Tennessee students entering Kindergarten-12th grade.

To participate in Tristar Reads, students and their parent or caregiver must register at www.tristarreads.com and log their reading hours throughout the summer. Reading logs will be submitted at the end of the summer to info@tnsuccess.org or by mail to Tristar Reads, P.O. Box 680231, Franklin, TN 37068.

Four \$1,000 scholarship awards will be presented to the students who read, log, and submit the most hours over the course of the summer. Tristar Reads will award a scholarship to the student who reads the most overall minutes, and to the students in each of three grade level bands who read the most: K-4th grade, 5th-8th grade, and 9th-12th grade.

Program Rules:

- Participating students must be entering Kindergarten-12th grade in Tennessee. Public, private, and home school students are all eligible to participate.
- All students must register to participate on the Tristar Reads website (tritarreads.com). Students under the age of 13 must have permission to participate in the program from a parent or caregiver.
- Students must keep track of all the hours they spend reading, and a list of the books read. Reading logs must be submitted to Tristar Reads at the end of the summer to determine scholarship winners.
- Students must submit their hours by August 15th, 2024. Mailed submissions postmarked by August 15th will be counted if they arrive at Tristar Reads by August 20th. Completed reading logs can be emailed to info@tnsuccess.org or mailed to Tristar Reads, P.O. Box 680231, Franklin, TN 37068.
- Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in September 2023 to the students who read the most: overall most minutes read, elementary student (K-4), middle school student (5-8), and high school student (9-12). Students' entering grade level in the fall of 2024 will determine their grade-level division.
- Scholarships will be directly deposited into the winning students' education savings account (529 Plan / TN Stars Account). Cash will not be awarded. More information about TN's 529 plans can be found at tnstars.org.
- Students who have previously been awarded major scholarships through Tristar Reads are welcome to participate but will not be eligible for scholarship awards. They will remain eligible for raffle prizes throughout the summer for participation.
